Even before he was born, it was known that he would be someone  
special. He received divine honors in the third century. And  
then he relates a third miracle of him, which was nothing less  
than that of his averting the plague.

If therefore we find Apollonius calling these Indians gods, and enrolling him  
he can never traverse the air with his body, however much he  
scorns to linger upon the paths of earth, without instantly  
paying the penalty of his folly; nor by spiritual exaltation  
can he in his thinking attain to the unattainable, without  
falling back into the disease of melancholy. And after an  
interval the other, who is king of the Indians, and a  
barbarian to boot, gets rid of the interpreter, and addresses  
Apollonius in Greek; and speaking in that language details to  
him his education and his wealth of learning.
