A cholesteatoma consists of squamous epithelium that is trapped within the skull base and that can erode and destroy important structures.

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cholesteatoma is clinically defined as an abnormal extension of skin into the middle ear and mastoid air cell spaces. the point of entrance of skin into the middle.

### **Cholesteatoma Causes, Symptoms, and Treatment**

A cholesteatoma is an abnormal, noncancerous skin growth that can develop in the middle section of your ear, behind the eardrum. It may be a birth defect, but it's most commonly caused by repeated middle ear infections. As these dead skin cells accumulate, the growth can increase.

## **Mastoidectomy to treat cholesteatoma or ear infection**

When this skin grows behind the ear drum or it grows into the bone behind the ear (mastoid bone), it is called a cholesteatoma. This skin grows at a much faster .
